


- Since January 2020 to June 2023, National CI value has increased 0.60 to 0.83
  - Both PNRI functional and service data has also improved.














#### **Key progress highlights**


- Compared to May 2023, no of children identified with SAM has decreased in June 23 (from 1.975 to 1,849). But the SAM admission rate has increased in June 23 (from 51% to 53%). On the other hand no. of SAM children admitted in SAM inpatient units (from 1,005 to 972) has decreased than the previous month (Figure 3).
- In June'23 the number of pregnant women receive IFA has decreased (from 290,676 to 267,130) in Figure 1 & The no. of caregiver receiving nutrition counselling has also decreased from 177,488 in May'23 to 164,191 in June'23) in Figure 2.


#### **Areas for improvements**

- All facilities should give report timely in DHIS2(within the first 5 working days of the month).
- Need to be increase the attention on quality of screening of SAM & distribution of IFA among PLW.
- There are need to expand the admission rate of children with SAM in inpatient Units.

Figure 1 SAM Admission Trend (2020-2023) Figure SAM Screening Trend (2020-2023)






- We had set the target for SAM admission at 14,000 children in 2023. Up to June 2023, we have already reached 6,203 which is 44.31% of set target.(Figure-1)
- We can see well progress in children screened with SAM in 2023 in compare to last three years. In June'23, the number of SAM children screened at SAM facility performed (369,900) (Figure-2).
- Before COVID lockdown in 2021, the admission rate was 94% (in April). SAM admission trend has slightly decreased in June'23 (972) than the previous month (1005).
- IYCF counselling and IFA coverage has shown here in Figure-3&4. However, now the coverage has slightly decrease in case of IYCF counselling than the previous month (from 177,488 to 164,191). On the other hand IFA distribution trend has decreased in June"23 (from 290,676 to 267,130).

#### IFA Distribution Trend (2020-2023)






- Khulna division is overall ranking top.
- Khulna division has highest % of facilities reporting on complete nutrition indicator (91%).
- Dhaka has the highest no. of PLW received IFA (53,320).
- Chattogram has the highest number for SAM screening (87,665) and SAM admission (222)
- Rajshahi has the highest number SAM identification (344).
- Sylhet has the highest % of SAM Admission (116%)

## DIVISION WISE SAM CASES IDENTIFIED VS ADMISSION June 2023




- Division wise variations has highly increased in terms of SAM cases identified from screening vs admission
- Out of Eight divisions, only five divisions has shown admission rate of SAM cases over 50%.

## **DISTRICT PERFORMANCE AND RANKING-PNRI DATA June 2023**



- The five top performing districts are- Narail, Jashore, Nilphamari, Barguna and Cox's Bazar
- Based on CI value, 5 districts has performed very poor, 9 districts has performed average, 47 districts performed good and 3 districts have shown over estimated performance.

 Based on CI value overall district performance has increased. 47 districts performed Good, Five (5) districts performed very poor (Narayanganj, Shariatpur, Munshiganj, Manikganj & Dhaka) and 9 districts performed average.
