



Compared to March 2023, no of children identified with SAM has decreased in April'23 (from 2,086 to 1,993). But the SAM admission rate has also remain same in Mar '23 (from 48% to 48%). On the other hand no. of SAM children admitted in SAM inpatient units (from 1,044 to 966) has decreased than the previous month (Figure 3).

In April'23 the number of pregnant women receive IFA has decreased (from 296,772 to **254,136)** in Figure 1 & The no. of caregiver receiving nutrition counselling has also decreased from 184,050 (Feb'23) to 159,949 (April'23) in Figure 2.

All facilities should give report timely in DHIS2(within the first 5 working days of the month). Need to be increase the attention on quality of screening of SAM & distribution of IFA


There are need to expand the admission rate of children with SAM in inpatient Units.

Figure 1 SAM Admission Trend (2020-2023) Figure 2 SAM Screening Trend (2020-2023)



We had set the target for SAM admission at 14,000 children in 2023. Up to April 2023, we have already reached 4,226 which is 30.19% of set target.(Figure-1)

- We can see well progress in children screened with SAM in 2023 in compare to last three years. In April'23, the number of SAM children screened at SAM facility performed (**391,043**) (Figure-2).
- Before COVID lockdown in 2021, the admission rate was 94% (in April). SAM admission trend has decreased in April'23 (966) than the previous month (1,002).
- IYCF counselling and IFA coverage has shown here in Figure-3&4. However, now the coverage has slightly decrease in case of IYCF counselling than the previous month (from 184,050 to 159,949). On the other hand IFA distribution trend has decreased in March"23 (from **296,772 to 254,136)**.






No of Children Identified with SAM No of SAM children admitted -Admission Rate

- Out of Eight divisions, only two divisions has shown admission rate of SAM cases over 50%.




DISTRICT PERFORMANCE AND RANKING-PNRI DATA April 2023
